All lessons shall be paid monthly. Rates are shown below.

Policies

New Students

All new students are subject to a one-month probationary period. Students who fail to show a proper level of effort and a good attitude may, at the instructor's discretion, be dismissed from the trumpet studio.

Referrals - Special Offer!

Should a current student refer a new student, *both the new student and the referring student* receive one month's lessons for half-price. This offer is applicable pending acceptance by the instructor of the student, and shall not be redeemed until the probationary period (one month) for the new student has passed. Contact the instructor to take advantage of this offer.

Prorating for New Students

A new student beginning his or her lessons in mid-month may pay a prorated amount (based on the monthly rate) for the first month.

Lesson Payment and Scheduling

Monthly lessons shall be paid in advance at the first lesson of each month. Payment is for the entire month, and shall remain the same, regardless of whether that month contains three, four or five scheduled lessons. Each calendar year will include approximately 48 scheduled lessons.

Student Cancellation of Lessons

The student shall inform the instructor of lesson cancellation no later than 48 hours prior to the lesson time. Lessons cancelled within 48 hours of scheduled lesson time will not be rescheduled or refunded, except in the case of illness or emergency.

If, for any reason, a student repeatedly cancels his lesson (whether within the 48 hour window or not) may be dismissed.

Instructor Cancellation of Lessons

Should the instructor be faced with a scheduling conflict, the instructor shall reserve the right to do one of the following:

1. arrange for a substitute teacher to be present,
2. to reschedule the lesson at the student's convenience, or
3. to give the student a full refund for the lesson (subtracted from the lesson payment for the following month).

Weather Cancellation/Rescheduling

Should the student's school be cancelled, delayed or dismissed early, the student shall not assume trumpet lessons are cancelled. In the event of a weather cancellation, the instructor shall contact each student, and one of the following shall occur:

1. the lesson shall be rescheduled for later in the week, or
2. the student shall receive a full refund for the lesson (subtracted from the lesson payment for the following month).

Lesson Rescheduling for Holidays

Should a major holiday fall on a lesson day, lessons shall either be cancelled or moved to another day during that week. Surf to <http://www.drewfennell.com/PriStu/index.html> to view a projected calendar and other details.

Dismissal of Students

The instructor reserves the right to dismiss any student whose effort and/or attitude is consistently substandard. A dismissed student shall be refunded, in a prorated amount, for any lessons for which the student has prepaid.
